

Cabbage Rose

A) Starting in the center, work your way around in a loose, curvey spiral. Leave ample space between each spiral. B) Randomly bring your stitching line back in to almost touch the line before, forming a petal. When you reach the desired size, add 2 leaves, and turn around. C) Loosely mimic the shape of the first leaf, adding a vein when you reach the end of the leaf. Repeat for the second leaf. Continue to work your way back around your flower, randomly echoing petals and crossing over the initial outline often, until you reach your starting point.
