Finished Size: 16 1/4"


Read all instructions carefully before starting.

Cutting Instructions	
For 1 Block	Red
Blue	(1) 1 ¼" x WOF
(4) 6 ½" x 6 ½"	(1) 2" x WOF
	(1) 2" x 3"
<u>White</u>	
(2) ¾" x WOF	
(2) 1" x WOF	NO inset seams!! NO paper piecing!!


All seam allowances are '4'' WOF= width of fabric Always press toward the darker fabric, unless otherwise noted.


The Diagonal Cross


- Start with the (2) ¾" x WOF white fabrics and the (1) 1 ¼" x WOF red fabric.
- Sew the white strips to either side of the red strip, lengthwise. Press.



- Cut this strip into (4) 10 1/8" segments.
- Cut all (4) of the 6 ½" squares in half on the diagonal.
- Start with 1 strip segment and 1 set of blue triangles. Pin the strip onto the long side of a triangle, leaving '2' of overhang on both ends. Stitch in place. Press.
- ullet Pin the second triangle onto the other side of the strip, following the same steps.
- Repeat to make (4) corner blocks. Trim each block to 7 1/8" x 7 1/8".










The Vertical Cross

- Start with the (2) 1" x WOF white fabrics and the (1) 2" x WOF red fabric.
- Sew the white strips to either side of the red strip, lengthwise. Press.



- Cut this strip into
 (2) 7 ½" segments and (2) 7 ½" segments.
- Using (2) of the prepared corner blocks and (1) 7 % 's segment, piece the top row. Be sure that the diagonals are point in the proper direction. (7 %' × 16 %')
- Repeat to make the bottom row.



• Using the (2) 7 %" segments and the 2" x 3" square, piece the center row.



Assemble all three rows as shown. Press.
